4. Review of previous goals/assess need to update

5. STEM connection to SIP -- looking ahead to renewing NC recognition status
Mr. Irvin briefly spoke about the need to develop a STEM educational plan that becomes a part of our SIP. This a requirement in order to achieve a "model" distinction in future STEM application renewals. It was decided by SIT that such a plan will require 2-3 years to fully develop and implement and a dedicated committee to work on it. Further, it was decided that the information should be shared with the faculty at an upcoming faculty meeting to lay the groundwork for such a committee.

NC Cooperative Innovative High Schools Design and Implementation Elements were briefly presented to possibly adjust committees to reflect CIHS Elements next school year: Future Ready Graduates, Collaborative Partnerships, Innovative Design and Operations, Innovative Practices, Personalized Student Supports, and Leadership and Professionalism.
